Getting to participate in the large Easter camp, a 5-day discipleship bike trip and teaching youth in discipleship programs are just some of the highlights of these past 3 months. We are about to embark on a trip to the US order to attend Victoria's high school graduation and to visit supporting churches in Texas and Oregon. Please pray for travel safety (crossing into Texas on Monday) and that we would be used to spur on the believers we'll be visiting to continue in their

service for Christ and His mission. We plan to return to Mexico in time to participate in the 3 weeks of youth camp here at Camp Berea.

Since the cartel head "El Mencho" was killed in February, the military has had a presence in Puruandiro and this seems to have calmed things down in regards to the shootings we were hearing regularly before that. Whether this will last or not, we are grateful that for the time being it seems the government is actively fighting against the cartel violence. We will continue to point people to the risen Lord Jesus, the only true Prince of Peace!

Thank you for your interest and love in the ministry we have been given. Without your prayers and support we would not be able to be here, proclaiming Christ and His power to save the lost. Nor would we have the freedom to focus on discipling and encouraging the flock to persevere through their various trials for His glory.
